

Deliver an educational experience and curriculum that prepares graduates to collaborate on inter-professional teams.

The Xavier University of Louisiana PA Program utilized three (3) outcome measures to determine Program effectiveness in meeting the program goal to deliver an educational experience and curriculum that prepares graduates to collaborate on inter-professional teams.

The three (3) benchmarks assigned to each outcome measures included: (1) All students enrolled in the Interprofessional Experience Course will pass with satisfactory grades/scores, (2) Existing students will rate the survey items that PA program curriculum includes instruction that prepare students to work collaboratively in interprofessional patient-centered teams at 70% or higher (3.5 on 5 point Likert scale), (3) Faculty will rate the survey item that the PA program curriculum includes instruction that prepares students to work collaboratively in interprofessional patient-centered teams at 70% or higher (2.8 on 4-point Likert scale).

The Xavier University of Louisiana PA program concluded that it met the program Goal for #4 which is to deliver an educational experience and curriculum that prepares graduates to collaborate on inter-professional teams for both the Class of 2022 and for the Class of 2023. Goal #4 has been determined to be a strength of the program based on at least two consecutive years of performance above the potential strength benchmark.
